# Party in the Park – 6 May 2019



- ▶ The 6<sup>th</sup> annual Party in the Park event, which was jointly organised by St Andrew's Church and AGRA, took place on Monday 6 May. We really appreciated the support that you gave us in so many ways – erecting marquees; selling raffle tickets; managing the children's entertainment; handing out programmes; litter picking; car parking; running stalls; cooking food; baking cakes, donating prizes, promoting neighbourhood watch and for attending the event. We believe that around 2,500 people attended throughout the day – which shows what a great community spirit there is around the area. We feel that we learn something from each annual event and think that this was probably the best Party in the Park that we have held so far. Your support and positive feedback was very much appreciated.








# Update on A45 – Park Hill Roundabout

- ▶ The changes to this roundabout have now been completed
- ▶ Coventry City Council Officers will continue to monitor the area until all the initial problems are resolved.
- ▶ Over the next month or so sensors will continue to respond to traffic volume and automatically make the appropriate changes where necessary.



## Update on Application to register Juniper Park as a Village Green

- The application was submitted at the end of November 2018 which included 41 petition signatories; 43 supportive written statements.
- The Planning Officer has confirmed that the application has been examined by CCC's legal department and that it is a valid application.
- The application has also been examined by the Land Registry and no issues were raised
- This consultation period closed on 25 April 2019
- The application will now be considered by Coventry City Council's Planning Committee – as yet a date for this meeting is to be decided.
